Very good trainees have a sound understanding and have rational decisions in conjunction with the patient, an effective communication and management. In the past they take account of the evidence base of medicine. They keep their work up to date and will actively participate in continuing education. They have insight into their limits and refer cases appropriately with a clear rationale of communication. They make sensible plans for future management and take account of a professional's limits at all times, showing empathy and compassion, respecting confidentiality and being aware of the need to spend health care money wisely. Their education shows knowledge, skills and attitudes, demonstrating their personal strengths and weaknesses and making appropriate plans to correct any deficiencies. Poor trainees approach cases on a very superficial level. They take important clinical considerations and fail to make rational decisions. They do not recognise the deeper implications of cases, particularly issues of confidentiality, empathy and professional conduct. They do not recognise their own limits. Their plans are illogical, disorganised, incomplete and unclear. They do not make appropriate referrals. They lack professionalism and do not take insight into their personal strengths and weaknesses. They do not make any plans for self-improvement.
